Quality Parenting Initiative QPI4Kids.org **Foster Care Support Organizations** are groups that meet regularly with other foster parents to provide information, encouragement, and occasional training to help families cope with their unique situations.

These meetings are for foster parents to have a safe space to share their personal experiences without fear of judgment. It's a comfortable environment where many others will have experienced similar situations and everyone can feel understood. You will discover you are not alone.

Foster parents gain and develop coping skills for concerns they may encounter during their journey by sharing personal experiences, and offer advice and guidance to those who need it.

While fostering, parents may experience a gamut of emotions at different points in the process. You will often find these feelings are validated as legitimate emotional responses to difficult issues. Your support group will celebrate the good times with you, and help provide understanding and guidance through the difficult times.

Foster Care Resource Organizations are groups that provide advocacy services, basic needs of children in foster care, and occasionally training for foster parents.
